

Droughtmaster Group Breedplan

Individual Droughtmaster herds have submitted performance records to Breedplan since 1985. All those records have now been combined into one single computer analysis: **Droughtmaster Group Breedplan.** This allows valid across-herd genetic comparisons to be made, both within and between years, covering many differing environments and management systems.

Only 2018 Group Breedplan EBVs or Interim EBVs with Accuracy (Acc) can be validly compared between Droughtmaster herds.

ESTIMATED BREEDING VALUES (EBVs)

The EBV is the best estimate of an animal's genetic merit for that trait.

ACCURACY (%)

Provides an indication of reliability of an EBV. As more performance information becomes available on an animal (or its progeny, or relatives) then the accuracy of its EBVs for particular traits will increase. For more information and detailed explanations contact Tropical Beef Technology Services Ph 0418 268 158.

FERTILITY

SS: Scrotal Size EBV (cm) is an indicator of male fertility in regards to semen quality and quantity. Higher (positive) EBVs indicate higher fertility. SS is also positively associated with female fertility.

GROWTH

Milk: 200-Day Milk EBV (kg) is an estimate of an animal's milking ability. For sires, this EBV is indicative of their daughter's milking ability as it affects the 200 day weight of their calves.

200: 200-Day Growth EBV (kg). This EBV is an estimation of the animal's genetic merit for 200-day growth calculated independently of the maternal milk effect.

400: 400-Day Weight EBV (kg). This EBV gives us an estimation of the animal's yearling weight potential.

600: 600-Day Weight EBV (kg). This EBV is the best single estmate of an animal's genetic merit for growth beyond yearling age.

Semen morphology

WHY SEMEN MORPHOLOGY TEST?

Semen Morphology is the count of normal sperm in an ejaculate from a bull. Some types of abnormal sperm are unable to fertilise while other types of abnormal sperm can fertilise the egg but then cause the embryo to die. It is therefore likely that a sexually active bull with a high percentage of normal sperm will be more fertile than one with a low percentage of normal sperm.

We believe that semen testing without the examination of sperm morphology is incomplete. The Bull Power Project found that semen quality, particularly the percentage of normal sperm, was onsistently related to the number of calves on the ground.

A semen morphology examination on all sale bulls will be conducted by Adam Wise B.V.Sc. in the time leading up to sale. The total normal percentage of sperm for each bull will be available on sale day.

Bulls with morphology results from 70% – 100% normal sperm are deemed as fertile for single sire mating.

Bulls with 50% – 69% are deemed as acceptable for multiple sire mating.

Test results are subject to change and are affected by sexual maturity, nutrition (too much or too little), the rate of weight gain or loss, age, genetics, injury, illness, relocation and environmental stresses.

By retesting the bulls that fail an initial test our aim is to identify those animals that have a genetic weakness or predisposition to be affected by outside factors and not put them up for sale.

Semen Morphology is just one part of bull fertility. Libido levels, serving ability related to structural soundness and sheath size and shape, and social dominance all influence calf output. A bull that passes a presale morphology test is not assured of being fertile for life and on the flip side, failure in a single morphology test does not mean a bull will be sub – fertile for life.

In conclusion, a pass for semen morphology does not guarantee high fertility but continued failure usually means relatively low fertility.

Clonlara sire summary 2023

CLONLARA 19216 — A big strong horned bull retained for his enormous capacity and bone. We've used him over homozygous polled cows and are really pleased with the calves. This is first drop. Represented by lot numbers **1**, **3**, **41**, **51**, **55**.

CLONLARA 19290 — A big growth homozygous polled bull with impeccable structure used over horned cows. This is his first drop of calves. Top 10% of the breed for 400 and 600 day growth on Droughtmaster Group Breedplan. Represented by lot numbers **2**, **18**, **21**, **27**, **28**, **29**, **45**, **53**.

CLONLARA 16173 — Broad muzzle, broader top, balance, meat....he's the full package.. Top 10% of the breed for 400 and 600 Day Growth and Milk EBV's on Droughtmaster Group Breedplan. 17 sons last year averaged \$21,205. This is the last chance to acquire a son as we unfortunately lost him last year. Represented by lot numbers **13**, **14**, **30**, **32**, **34**, **42**, **43**, **44**.

YARALLA ARTHUR — Purchased Artesian Sale for \$24,000 he's a big stretchy bull with impeccable structure and faultless temperament. This is his first drop of calves offered. Represented by lot numbers **4**, **24**, **50**.

NEEDMOR EMMETT — Purchased for \$28,000 DN Sale 2018. An easy doing bull with an exceptional carcase and tidy underline. At 22 months of age he was 836kg, 43cm

scrotal and 143 EMA. Sons sold to date have averaged \$13,750. Represented by lot numbers **14**, **31**, **40**, **49**.

CLONLARA 17299 — Retained out of a first calf heifer, his growth, bone and strength of head made him stand out in the crowd. Top 10% of the breed for 200 and 400 Day Growth and top 5% for Scrotal Size and 600 Day Growth EBVs on Droughtmaster Group Breedplan. Represented by lot numbers **5**, **7**, **12**, **15**.

GARTHOWEN XAVIER 2 — Purchased DN Sale for \$75,000 this is a bull with outstanding balance, softness and fleshing. Sons offered to date have averaged over \$15,000. Represented by lot numbers **6**, **11**, **39**, **58**.

OASIS A SUGAR RAY — A big growth horned bull purchased at DN for \$24,000. We purchased this bull for his tremendous bone and breed character to put over some lighter polled cows. Unfortunately 3 day sickness meant his breeding career was cut short. Represented by lot numbers **16**, **22**, **56**.

CLONLARA 17253 — A big growthy son of Locarno Gus with an outstanding carcase and tidy sheath. Top 5% of the breed for 200, 400 and 600 Day Growth and Top 10% of the breed for Scrotal Size on Droughtmaster Group Breedplan. Represented by lot numbers **9**, **19**, **23**, **33**, **35**, **36**, **37**, **38**, **47**.

Looking after your Clonlara bull

We have made every effort here at Clonlara to present fit and healthy bulls ready for a long working life. Whilst all bulls on offer have met our strict fertility requirements it is well known that environmental and management changes can influence a bull's fertility. Below are a few points that may help your Clonlara bull readily adjust to his new home with minimal stress and therefore minimal effect on his fertility.

- Clonlara bulls are prepared on a silage ration and every effort is made to present bulls that will let down easily to a pasture environment. Whilst your Clonlara bull should adjust readily to most paddock situations, if nutrition is particularly low it would be helpful to supplement the bull's diet for a short time so the nutritional shock is not too large. A sharp decrease in nutrition can have an adverse effect on semen quality.
- Our bulls are generally handled in large groups with horses, dogs and motorbikes. Whilst generally quiet to handle they do not have a lot of one on one handling. Following sale day bulls are often trucked in small groups or on their own and dropped into strange environments. This is a very stressful situation for them and it is a good idea to have cattle ready for your bull to mix with on arrival, particularly if he is on his own. Leaving a bull in the yard on his own is very stressful to him and

is the worst thing you can do. Our bulls respect fences and you can be confident of letting them out in a paddock with other cattle in a less stressful environment to adapt to his new home.

- If possible avoid mixing young bulls with older bulls as they tend to be dominated and may not get their fair share of calves. Running them with older bulls also increases the chances of your young bulls being injured.
- Your young bull is likely to lose condition faster than your older bulls due to the fact that he is still growing and he is still adjusting to his new environment. If the condition of a bull gets too low fertility (semen quality) can be compromised. If possible attempt to look after your young bull on quality pasture or similar following his first mating season to ensure his continued fertility for the following season.
- Please remember that while your bulls are vaccinated, boosters are necessary annually to ensure continued coverage against disease.

We have done all we can to ensure you get the most out of your Clonlara bull. With a little TLC you will help ensure that you get the most from him. Please contact us if we can be of any assistance.

The Clonlara Composite

The Clonlara Composite program began in the mid 1990's after Ed McCormack undertook a study tour to the USA with a group of like-minded cattlemen who saw that there was a demand for bulls adapted to sub-tropical environments and suited to production for the grain fed sector.

To produce bulls better suited to the grain fed sector at Clonlara we saw that we needed to reduce Bos Indicus content whilst maintaining the environmental adaptability and cow production we already had in our Droughtmaster cow unit.

The two main reasons for reducing Bos Indicus content were:

- Increasing carcase and meat quality
- Reducing age at sexual maturity

We set out on a composite breeding program to produce cattle that would survive and thrive in sub-tropical environments with:

- Early sexual maturity
- Moderate mature size
- Sufficient growth for short/ mid fed markets
- Moderate to high meat quality
- Excellent temperament

Initially after extensive research we introduced Tuli (African Bos Taurus) and South Devon (British) into our commercial herd to end up with a composite that was ½ Clonlara Droughtmaster (50 % British 50 % Bos Indicus), ¼ Tuli (100% African Bos Taurus) and ¼ South Devon (100 % British) . Essentially this meant the Clonlara Composite was 25 % Bos indicus 25% African 50% British.

We stablised this composite for a period of time however saw the need to keep hybrid vigour working, and have since used different composite bulls over Droughtmaster cows to breed bulls to introduce into our composite program. Greg Chappell's Currawee Composite bulls were extensively used and the Warby's Billinbah Composites have also been used. This introduced Belmont Red / Bonsmara, Angus, Shorthorn, Black Simmental and some Santa Gertrudis genetics into our Composite program.

The Composite herd we have now is a mixture of Bos Indicus, African and British genetics featuring a number of breeds, however through continued trait driven selection we have a very uniform type and an extremely efficient herd of red cattle that are fertile, productive and sought after. Essentially we have stayed close to the 25 % Bos Indicus, 25% African, 50 % British mix.

The need for an easy care female in a broad acre environment remains foremost in our breeding objectives, and the Clonlara Composite we have today is an efficient cow herd producing flat back calves ideally suited to

- MSA and Coles and Woolies markets
- 100 day grainfed export markets
- Grass finishing

There are currently 900 composite females preg-tested in calf at Clonlara. We sell over 100 Composite bulls yearly and they are working from the top end of the NT, all over QLD and into NSW.

All bids shall be treated as offers made upon the following Terms and Conditions of Sale and all persons present are admitted to attend the sale on the basis that they have notice of these Terms and Conditions.

- 1. The highest bidder shall, subject to Condition 2, be the purchaser provided that the vendor reserves the right to bid either by himself or through his agent or auctioneer and should any dispute arise among the bidders for any lot, during or immediately after sale of the lot, it shall be settled at the auctioneer's absolute discretion who may, should one of the disputants advance, put the lot or lots up again. The bidding from time to time shall be regulated by the auctioneer and no bid shall be retracted.
- 2.  - (ii) The vendor and the purchaser shall resolve the dispute between themselves:

- 8. - 9. For the purposes of this condition, the expression "The AMBA Bill Rate" is the rate published by the Australian Merchant Banker's Association in good faith as at the date of the sale as its Bill Rate for 180 day Bills of Exchange expressed as a percentage per annum. The auctioneer is not liable in respect of any error, misdescription or omission in any particulars appearing or stated regarding the description or pedigrees of any lot offered for sale and no such error, misdescription or omission shall entitle the purchaser to annul the sale or reject the lot or claim any compensation, damage or abatement in price.
- 16 (b) Each lot will be sold subject to passing all veterinary tests required by the law of the State or country to which the purchaser intends to transport that particular lot, such tests to be undertaken at the purchaser's expense and concluded immediately following the sale. In the

event of a lot failing to pass these tests, the sale shall be null and void, any purchase moneys paid by the purchaser shall be refunded and property in the lot shall revert to or remain with the vendor.

- 17. GUARANTEES OF FERTILITY
- 17. 1 BULLS. Save and except for calves at foot, all bulls are guaranteed breeders and to so prove within six months of the date of sale or by reaching the age of 30 months, whichever date shall be later.
- 17. 2 FEMALES. Save and except for calves at foot, all females are guaranteed to be in calf or go into calf within six months of the date of sale or by the age of 30 months whichever date shall be the later. A positive pregnancy test certified by a qualified veterinary surgeon shall be sufficient evidence that the animal is in calf.
- 17. 3 Claims under clauses 17.1 and 17.2 guarantees of fertility shall be made to the vendor within six months from the date of sale or prior to the animal entering a quarantine area other than on the vendor's property.
- 17. 3 1 All claims must be accompanied by a veterinary certificate which shall clearly identify the basis of the claim.
- 17. 3 2 Infertility resulting from injury or disease occurring after the sale of the animal shall not be covered by this guarantee.
- 17. 3 3 The vendor retains the right to have the animal placed on a property nominated by him or returned to his own property for further assessment of fertility for a period not exceeding six months. In the event of the animal being proven fertile within the period, the costs incurred shall be borne by the purchaser. In the event of the animal not being proven fertile within the period the costs incurred shall be borne by the vendor.
- 17. 4 LIABILITY OF A VENDOR. Except for costs defined elsewhere in the Conditions of Sale, the liability of a vendor in respect of claims relating to fertility shall not exceed the purchase price of the animal(s) or to provide mutually agreed upon replacement animals.
- 17. 5 REFUNDS. In the event of a claim being substantiated and the purchase price being refunded, the animal(s) shall automatically become the property of the vendor and be returned to him or disposed of according to his instructions at this expense.
- 17. 6 This guarantee shall be voided by the purchaser if:-
 - (a) The animal is returned to the vendor-
 - (i) in poor physical condition or with any injury;
 - tests carried out on behalf of the vendor within fourteen days of such return proved positive to any diseases which may affect the animal's fertility or ability to breed naturally; or
 - (b) The purchaser has collected and stored semen from a bull or embryos from a female.
- 17. 7 In the event of a dispute as to whether a lot is a breeder, such dispute shall be resolved by the vendor and the purchaser, and the auctioneer, while he shall use his best endeavours to assist, shall have no liability or responsibility in that regard. In the event that a lot is alleged or proved not to be a breeder, the purchaser shall nevertheless be obliged to pay the auctioneer the full purchase price and any other moneys or interest payable by the purchaser in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.
- 18. (a) Each lot shall be at the risk of the vendor in respect of any damage or injury, whether by disease, accident or otherwise, for the period that the lot be in the custody of the auctioneer, PROVIDED THAT the auctioneer, its servants, agents and employees shall use all reasonable care to protect and control the lot while it is in the auctioneer's custody AND PROVIDED THAT when a lot has been sold, it shall be at the risk of the purchaser in all respects.
- 18. (b) If any vendor brings to the sale premises any lot which is dangerous, or infected with any disease, that vendor shall be liable for all injury, damages, costs, losses or expenses which the auctioneer may sustain, incur or be put to either directly or indirectly as a result of the vendor so doing. The auctioneer reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, to exclude from the sale venue or dispose of any lot which in its opinon shows signs of any disease, whether infectious, contagious or not, or of any serious fault or of being dangerous.

- 19. DELIVERY. Except at the discretion of the auctioneer, no lot shall be delivered to the purchaser unless payment of the purchase money together with any additional charges incurred including those expenses incurred by the auctioneer, pursuant to Condition 14 hereof, is first made by the purchaser to the auctioneer.  - (iii) "Flush" means the unfertilised ova or eggs of the donor cow before those ova or eggs are fertilised by a sire recommended or to be nominated by the vendor and taken from the donor cow and transferred to any one or more surrogate cows.
 - (iv) "Surrogate cow" means the cow to which the embryo deriving from a flush is transferred at any time.
 - "Sire" means the male parent specified in this sales catalogue to be the sire of an embryo or of a flush (where the flush is fertilised).
 - (vi) "Dam" means the donor cow specified in the sale catalogue as being the dam of an embryo or of a flush.
 - (b) In the event that a lot sold pursuant to these Terms and Conditions is an embryo or a flush the above general Terms and Conditions of Sale and this Condition 21 shall apply, but where any inconsistency occurs, the said general Terms and Conditions shall be varied to the extent of any such inconsistency by the provisions of this Condition 21. The definition of "Lot" contained in Condition 20 shall be read to include the embryo(s) or flush(es) offered for sale and/or sold by the auctioneer on behalf of a vendor.
 - (c) Property in the embryo or the flush shall pass to the purchaser in accordance with Conditions 9 hereof. Property in any recipient cow carrying the embryo shall pass to the purchaser:
 - (a) where the recipient cow carries the embryo as at the date which property in the embryo passes pursuant to this condition, on such date, or
 - (b) where the recipient cow does not carry the embryo as at the date which property in the embryo passes pursuant to this Condition, on such later date as the embryo is transferred to the surrogate cow.
 - (d) No sale of an embryo or a flush shall be frustrated, invalidated or otherwise affected and no reduction in the sale price or compensation or damages shall be allowable or payable by reason of—
 - (i) the failure of the recipient cow to give birth to a live, healthy and sound calf;
 - (ii) the failure of a flush for any reason to transfer into one or more live embryos;
 - (iii) the failure of any one or more surrogate cows, hereafter carrying embryos derived from a flush sold to the purchaser, to give birth to one or more live, healthy or sound calves;
 - (iv) the death or incapacity of the surrogate cow or recipient cow, whether before or after the birth of the calf;

(v) the death or incapacity of the donor cow carrying the embryo or the flush at any time subsequent to the sale, and the purchaser agrees that it shall pay the full purchase price and any moneys payable to the auctioneer in accordance with these Terms and Conditions notwithstanding the occurrence of any one of the above circumstances.

(e) (i) Where the lot sold pursuant to these Conditions of Sale is an embryo:-

- (a) the embryo and the recipient cow at any time carrying the embryo shall in all respects be at the risk and expense of the purchaser from the time of acceptance of his bid or acceptance of his offer by the vendor or the auctioneer on behalf of the vendor; and
- (b) if the purchaser elects (with the consent of the vendor) to leave the lot he has purchased on the property of the vendor until a date subsequent to the sale, the vendor shall take reasonable care of the lot whilst the lot remains in the vendor's possession PROVIDED THAT the vendor's maximum liability in damages in the respect shall in all cases be limited to refunding the purchase price paid by the purchaser for the lot; and

 - (c) the vendor shall take reasonable care for the lot whilst the lot remains in the vendor's possession PROVIDED THAT the vendor's maximum liability in damages in this respect shall in all cases be limited to refunding the purchase price paid by the purchaser for the lot; and
 - (d) the vendor shall be under no obligation to deliver the lot until such time as the embryo(s) derived from the flush sold to the purchaser are transferred to the surrogate cow(s); and

- The vendor reserves the right to charge the purchaser a management fee of an amount specified by the vendor for every week or part thereof that:---
- in the case of a lot sold as an embryo, the dam carrying the embryo, or following embryo transfer, the recipient cow, or following calving, the subject calf remains in the vendor's possession: or
- in the case of a lot sold as a flush, the dam carrying the flush, or following embryo transfer, the surrogate cow(s), or following calving, the subject calves remain in the vendor's possession.
- (g) The purchase price payable in respect to a lot comprising an embryo or a flush shall be due and payable to the auctioneer in accordance with the provisions of Condition 9 hereof.
- (h) The vendor guarantees that:-

(f)

- in the case of a sale of an embryo, the recipient cow will carry a live embryo of the sire and dam specified in the particulars contained in the sales catalogue;
- (ii) in the case of the sale of a flush, the dam specified in the sales catalogue will produce a live flush containing a minimum of two (2) fertilised eggs.
